The **Southeastern Residency Conference (SERC)** will be held **April 26-27, 2012** at the Classic Center in **Athens, GA**. SERC's purpose is to serve as a forum for pharmacy residents from the Southeastern region to present the results of their clinical research. This is also a networking opportunity for future leaders in pharmacy and the current generation of thought leaders in the profession.

New Information for Registering and Earning Continuing Education Credit

Registration for SERC 2012 is now open! Registration and credit card payment is on UGA's **College of Pharmacy Continuing Education website**. This year the two-day conference is divided into seven sessions (referred to as courses on the registration website) and attendees will earn up to 10.5 hours of continuing pharmacy education credit. Even if you may not attend the entire conference, you should register for **ALL** seven sessions by checking the box beside each course listing during the registration process. This will allow you to earn credit for each session you attend in its entirety. Attendance at all of the abstract presentations in a session and completion of the program evaluation are required to receive continuing pharmacy education credit. *Partial session credit is NOT permitted*. During the conference, participants will be given complete instructions for claiming continuing education credit. Upon completion of the online evaluation, you may claim your credit based on the number of sessions you attended and then print your Statement of Credit.

Who Should Attend?

The Southeastern Residency Conference is intended for residents, graduate students, teachers, and preceptors in institutional pharmacy and other individuals associated with or interested in residencies and/or institutional practice.

CPE Monitor

Beginning Winter 2012, all pharmacists and pharmacy technicians will be required to have an e-Profile with NABP and received their unique identification number. *This 6-digit ID will be required when registering for SERC*.
